A federal lawsuit has been filed in the United States District Court for the Central District of California, against the City of Los Angeles and certain city employees. The case involves claims that the curfews in the above gang injunctions are unconstitutional. A class action is a lawsuit in which one or more people sue for themselves and for others who have similar claims. This Notice has been published for the purpose of informing you that your rights may be affected by this lawsuit.

NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION

You are further notified that the Court has declared that language in each of the curfew provisions contained in each of the above mentioned gang injunctions is unconstitutional. Therefore, persons will not be stopped, detained or arrested for violating the curfew restrictions imposed by any of the above gang injunctions.
